

WILLOWBROOK HANDICAP POLICY & PROCEDURES

Each golf club or authorized golf association utilizing the USGA Handicap System must appoint a Handicap Committee to ensure the integrity of each Handicap Index it issues. This Committee must make certain that the members comply with the USGA Handicap System.

The Handicap Committee has set forth the following policies and procedures for all Willowbrook Mens Club Members.

1. Post all acceptable rounds, including 9 hole scores.
2. Scores must be posted within 7 days of round played.
3. Equitable Stroke Control must be applied to all scores for posting purposes.

What is an Acceptable Score?

If 13 or more holes are played in an 18 hole round

If 7 to 12 holes are played for a 9 hole round

Match play, stroke play, and team competitions

If a player picks up when out of contention, including team competitions

If a player is disqualified from a competition but has an acceptable score it must
Be posted

All acceptable scores must be posted within 7 days using any one of the following methods.

Posting computer at any golf course utilizing GHIN

Return to Handicap Chairman for posting

Disciplinary Actions for failure to post correct adjusted scores or player manipulating their Handicap Index:

1. First failure to post correctly or potential manipulation of a score will result in a warning (verbal, e-mail, telephone) from Handicap Chairman
2. Second failure will result in written notice from Handicap Committee
3. Third failure will result in the appropriate penalty round issued for scores not posted or not posted correctly.

A player must earn a Handicap Index. No player has an inherent right to a Handicap Index without full evidence of ability to our Mens Club Handicap Committee. The Handicap Committee has the ultimate authority and obligation to adjust a Handicap Index if it feels necessary to do so.
